Christopher P. Holstege, M.D. is a University of Virginia Professor of Emergency Medicine and Pediatrics within the School of Medicine, Chief of the Division of Medical Toxicology, and Executive Director of the Student Health & Wellness Department. Dr. Holstege clinically provides care for poisoned patients and serves as a practicing member of the emergency medicine faculty. He is leading efforts in the care, health surveillance, and protection of the collegiate student population. He has numerous ongoing research projects in clinical, basic science and epidemiologic arenas. Dr. Holstege has over 200 publications in medical journals, periodicals, and books. He has edited or authored 10 books and is the lead editor of the book entitled *Criminal Poisoning – Clinical and Forensic Perspectives*. He is a Diplomate of both the American Board of Emergency Medicine and the American Board of Medical Toxicology.
