

Event Information

Overview

The VCU Annual Comprehensive Stroke Symposium features noted faculty and experts in the field. As an academic tertiary referral center, VCU cares for complex stroke patients, pediatrics to adults, throughout the continuum of care from emergency care to in-patient rehabilitation and out-patient stroke clinics. This one-day conference will focus on customizing stroke patient care for the individual needs of different populations, treating fever for better outcomes, optimizing management of carotid artery disease and providing patient-centered resources and tools to enhance transition of care.

Objectives

After attending the symposium, the learner will:

- Apply the newest acute ischemic stroke guidelines and temperature management guidelines in their practice
- Appropriately assess patients with challenging neuro exams for acute ischemic stroke
- Describe the unique stroke risk factors and management for women
- Summarize the management of carotid artery disease
- Recognize the impact of stroke on the young stroke survivor
- Recommend recreational therapy and community resources to enhance recovery
- Prepare stroke patients for anticipated challenges after discharge
